Dear Members following on from our recent notification about the state of the course there have been some further developments.

Front 9

The pumping system at the dam behind 4 has been substantially completed and we have now introduced council STEDS water to run in tandem with our bore water.

Back 9

We have a good flow of water going into the dam at 11 now and this will result in the ground staff giving all fairways a big drink over the duration of our autumn dryness . We will continue to hand water greens to assist the reconditioning and maintenance of greens, including the 4th which is on the improve.

The above are positive developments and you will see a noticeable improvement on the course.

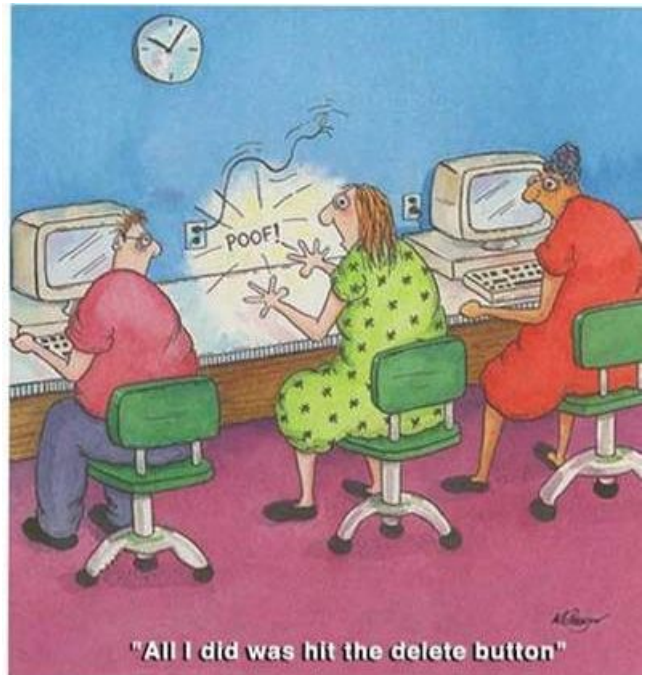

2024 Women's Pennant Competition

We were able to enter our usual 2 teams into the competition again this year, in Div 2 Hills and Div 3. Elizabeth Handsaker did a wonderful job as Pennant Co-ordinator and Captain of the Div 2 team.
