A big thanks to the Volunteers who have been busy around the course, their efforts are much appreciated by all who play at Echunga.


This year's reciprocal Winter fees for Echunga Members playing at Murray Bridge, are listed on Page 5.

VOLUNTEERS' REPORT

Welcome Terry, to the ranks. Garden pruning has been finished and those plants lost during the long dry will be replaced in Spring.

The clean-up around the dam is finished, with the area around the creek entrance to be landscaped at the end of Winter.

Drains have been cleaned out, just in time it seems. The bridge between the 3rd and 4th fairways has been re-built to allow better access for machinery and a name plate placed at Tom's tree, as well as new rails for the bridge leading to the 5th fairway. Still cutting up and removing fallen branches and work in progress to eradicate new growth in the walls of the mixing dam, as well as poisoning of blackberry bushes in the area.

The boundary wire behind the 2nd green was repaired and mulch spread in the car park, on the path behind the practise nets and around the 9th and 8th tees.


